

Burnsville Man, Woman Charged with Passing Bong with Marijuana to Child

Prosecutors say a Burnsville man and woman have been charged after police saw them pass a bong with marijuana to an 11-year-old child, who proceeded to smoke from it.

Burnsville police were called at 9:12 p.m. Sunday, March 13, after a woman reported feeling unsafe because of a situation involving an acquaintance.

Police arrived to find that the acquaintance had gone to a home across the street. Officers approached the home and could see into a bedroom window where a man and woman were sitting on a bed smoking out of a bong, according to the criminal complaint.

Police said they saw a boy come into the room. They said the man put more marijuana into the bong and then the woman passed it to the child.

Police say the man and woman passed the bong back and forth and that the child smoked out of it three times.

The man was identified as 31-year-old Adam Isaac Fidelman, and the woman was identified as 32-year-old Danielle Marie Habisch, both of Burnsville.

The boy is 11 years old, and police also say a 10-year-old girl was sleeping in another bedroom.

Police say they recovered a baggie of marijuana during a search.

Fidelman and Habisch have each been charged with a third-degree controlled substance crime, contributing to the delinquency of a minor and two counts of child endangerment.

If convicted, they each face up to 20 years in prison and \$250,000 in fines on the controlled substance crime and up to one year in prison and \$3,000 in fines on each of the other charges.

Court records show Fidelman's jury trial has been scheduled for July 18, and Habisch's trial has been scheduled for Sept. 19.
